Cleaning Regular cleaning of the disabled toilet/ facilities will take place, namely cleaning and disinfecting objects and surfaces that are touched regularly (namely areas of high use such as door/ gate/ toilet handles, light switches, etc.). Appropriate cleaning products and methods to be used. Members need to ensure however they minimise contact with objects and wash their hands immediately before and after use of toilet facilities/ clubhouse.
